Synchro Swim Ontario is now accepting coach applications for the 2019 11-12 Provincial Team and 2019 13-15 Provincial Team, which will each consist of 1 position of HEAD COACH (paid), 1 position of ASSISTANT COACH (paid) and 1 position of APPRENTICE COACH (unpaid/volunteer). Coaches will report directly to the Synchro Swim Ontario Executive Director (or designate) and will liaise with the Sport Development Manager, who will oversee and monitor the team.

- Have NLS and SFA/CPR-C (Required for Head Coach, asset for Assistant/Apprentice)
- Have a current Police Record Check, passport, and other signed documents as per Synchro Swim Ontario Policies
- Have a current Drivers License (for Head/Assistant)
- Be member in good standing with the Association
- Be a mature, knowledgeable, and experienced coach
- A suitable ambassador of our province at both training events and at competition
- Other credentials as per the Job Descriptions

Interview Dates: Interviews will be scheduled to take place in the weeks following the application

deadline. It is anticipated that Head Coach positions will be appointed by mid-

February, with Assistant/Apprentice Coach positions to follow.

Hiring Committee:

All interviews and the determination of successful candidates are at the discretion of the 2019 Provincial Teams Hiring Committee which will be comprised of the Executive Director, the Sport Development Manager (or designate), and a member of the Board of Directors, and/or a designated Technical Expert.

On this form, applicants will be asked to complete basic personal information and will be asked to complete three questions in lieu of a cover letter (contained within the form). Two references are to be provided, and a pdf version of the applicant's resume is to be uploaded (please ensure that in addition to typical resume items, your resume also reflects your coaching experience, including highlighting significant results).

Upon submission of the application form, a confirmation email containing a copy of the applicant's submission will be sent to the email address provided.
