IMPORTANT: <u>DO NOT</u> pass applications to staff or board members to submit on your behalf, nor email applications to staff email addresses. Applications MUST be mailed or faxed to the Ontario Artistic Swimming office or emailed to questforgold@ontarioartisticswimming.ca <u>ONLY</u> or they will not be considered valid or to have been received by the deadline.

Any athlete requesting a "Residency Exception" must submit this information by Thursday, March 26, 2020 as detailed in the Selection Criteria.

It is the sole responsibility of the athlete to provide a full and complete application that meets all stated requirements. Ontario Artistic Swimming will neither review applications in advance of the deadline in order to make applicants aware of any missing/incorrect information and/or attachments nor make corrections on behalf of the athlete. Any revisions on the part of the athlete will only be accepted prior to the posted submission deadline.

Applications that are sent directly to the Ministry of Heritage, Sport, Tourism and Culture Industries rather than to Ontario Artistic Swimming will not be considered valid or to have been received by the Ontario Artistic Swimming deadline.

An email will be sent by **Friday, March 27, 2020** confirming receipt. It is the athlete's responsibility to contact Ontario Artistic Swimming if this email is not received to be certain that the application has been successfully received by the deadline date.

The Sports Organization – Athlete Agreement will only come into effect if an athlete is selected and accepts carding status through the OAAP program. Athletes who fail to return a signed Athlete Agreement by the deadline date will not be carded.

Ontario Artistic Swimming will publish or make known a draft list of athletes nominated for Ontario Card status by no later than **April 8, 2020**.
