



Royal City Artistic Swimming Club Coach – Job Posting

Royal City Artistic Swimming Club (RCASC) is a not-for-profit sports club serving Guelph and the surrounding area which is managed by a volunteer Executive Board. Our Club offers programs for swimmers of all ages and abilities and aims to foster a love of sport and develop leadership skills in all our athletes. We are seeking coaches for our recreation, novice and provincial competitive program.

Our training takes place at the University of Guelph Red Pool and the Victor Davis Pool at the Victoria Road Recreation Centre in Guelph. We offer a competitive hourly wage and will provide financial support for coach training.

Responsibilities include:

- Developing the annual training plan and weekly lesson plans for assigned team.
- Attending weekly practices and providing artistic swimming instruction (in-pool and dryland) under the direction of the Head Coach.
- Use a variety of techniques to demonstrate skills include coach demonstrations in the water.
- Develop athletes at all levels that have good sportsmanship, healthy self-esteem and an appreciation for the sport of artistic swimming.
- Provide a minimum of two formal feedback opportunities to athletes throughout the season.
- Ensure athletes follow all safety protocols (including and COVID protocols) while on land and in the pool.
- Utilize Google Classroom for team communications and virtual training throughout the season.
- Attend coach meetings as required.
- Attend all competitions as required.

Minimum Qualifications:

- AquaGo Coach Trained or Competition Coach Trained (or in progress)
- Current Police Record Check
- Experience in coaching in artistic swimming
- Computer proficiency (e.g. Word, Google Classroom)

Other information:

- All coaches will report directly to our Head Coach.
- This is an annual contract starting August 1st.
- Practices commence in early September and continue until the first week of June.
