BYES

As the final event of the competitive season, byes will not be required for this competition.

SCRATCHES

Scratches may be submitted digitally until the start of the competition. To submit a scratch, [click here](#). Once the competition has begun, scratches must be made on deck at the scoring table.

EVENT STREAMS

Please note that this event is for Provincial Stream athletes only, and as such will not be streamed.

EXHIBITION ENTRIES

Out of Province (OOP) entries will be entered as exhibition entries at this event.

SPACING

Spacing practice will be offered to clubs on Wednesday, May 28. This training time is optional and will be scheduled based on distance from the competition location, with clubs closest to the venue first, and clubs furthest from the venue last.

Spacing time allowances per club will be calculated based on entries per club. Registrars are asked to indicate on their registration package if they wish to book spacing time.

Please note that spacing time will be an additional fee of \$25.00 per 5 minute interval. Each club's total spacing fee will be provided following the close of registration.

This event will also be the designated presentation time for Athlete, Coach and Volunteer of the Year Awards for the 2024-2025 season.

FIGURES

FIGURE DRAWS: 10U & 11-12 ATHLETES

10U & 11-12 athletes will compete two (2) figures at this event. These figures will be comprised of one (1) compulsory figure, and one (1) optional group figure drawn at random.

FIGURE DRAWS: ADAPTED ATHLETES

Adapted athletes will compete two (2) figures at this event, comprised of one group drawn at random. One group will be selected for all Adapted levels

FIGURE DRAWS: YOUTH ATHLETES

Youth athletes will compete two (2) figures at this event, following CAS procedure.

Two weeks prior to the competition the Section (Group A, B or C) and Group # will be drawn.

There will be two panels of judges for this event. All Youth athletes will compete the same two figures

FIGURE DRAW DATE

Figure draws will be done two weeks prior to the event, on Wednesday, May 15, 2025.

FIGURE EVENT PROCEDURE

Similar to last season, Figure events will be done in grouped sessions of 50 athletes. A detailed figure schedule will be provided closer to the event in addition to draws.

COACH CARD SUBMISSION

SUBMISSION DEADLINE

Sunday, May 25th, 2025 at 11:00 PM EST

DROPBOX ACCESS

OAS will request coach card files from be submitted into an OAS-owned Dropbox folder.

Head coaches will receive access to the submission folder via email following registration.

RESUBMISSION GUIDELINES

Coach card submissions are considered final, aside from the following exceptions:

Medical Issue

Clubs who need to change a coach card because of a medical issue that prevents them from performing a routine as per submitted coach card will be allowed to change their coach card up to 2 hours before the start of a session (event blocks will be considered one session). These changes will need to be approved by the Referee.

Changes between Prelims and Finals

In the event of Prelim and Finals, clubs are permitted to resubmit coach cards ahead of a Final event. Specific submission windows will be provided ahead of the event, and cards received following the prescribed deadline will not be accepted.

RESUBMISSION GUIDELINES (CONT.)

Last Resort Desperation Move

Clubs who want to change coach cards for reasons other than the 2 above will be allowed to do so no later than 8:00 PM the night before an event, but will need to pay a \$100 fine to do so.

New coach cards will always need to be submitted by email to Laura Steacy and Lauren Lindner, and updated in your club's Dropbox folder.

Confirmation of updated coach cards will be provided by email.

ENTRY SUBMISSIONS

Each club must submit their Excel registration booklet which includes a routine and figure entry list, invoice cost calculation and ISS-compatible athlete registration spreadsheet.

Registrars will receive full instructions for completing their registration booklet by email.

ATHLETE FEE

OUT OF PROVINCE FEE

In addition to the above event entry fees and athlete fees, clubs attending from out of province or out of country (OOP) will be charged an additional \$75.00 fee per athlete.

LATE ENTRIES

Club entry packages which are not received or incomplete upon the stated deadline is automatically subject to a late fine of \$25.00 per routine.

For Ontario sanctioned competitions, late entries or corrections to incomplete entries will be accepted beyond two weeks prior to the event start date, but will be subject to the following fines:

Within 24 hours of the first event of the competition: \$100.00 per correction (to a maximum of \$500.00 per Club) Fines apply per figure event and/or per routine per event.

MUSIC SUBMISSION

MUSIC SUBMISSION DEADLINE

Routine music files must be received no later than one week prior to the start of the competition, by **Friday, May 23, 2025.**

DROPBOX ACCESS

To avoid issues of Dropbox storage space, OAS will request music files from each coach be submitted into an OAS-owned Dropbox folder.

Head coaches will receive access to the submission folder via email following registration.

Music files must be labelled with the following information, separated by underscores with NO blank spaces (underscores are acceptable).

- 3. Club Call Letters**
- 4. Athlete Last Name**

FILE FORMAT

Digital music will be used at this competition. There must be one digital file for each registered routine in an mp3 format, with a minimum required resolution of 192kbps.

Coaches are asked to review each digital file for quality, timing and completeness. Please ensure that volume is consistent throughout all cuts of music.

METADATA & ID3 TAGS

Metadata (also known as ID3 tags for MP3 files) is information (such as title, artist, album, genre etc.) that is stored inside the song file.

This is often different from the name of the file itself. In order to avoid confusion at the competition music table, we ask coaches to ensure that the title of the song file, and the ID3 tag title of the song file are the same.

AWARDS

FIGURE EVENTS

OAS Medals (rank 1-3) and OAS Ribbons (rank 4-6) will be awarded to the top six ranked athletes in each category. In the case of exhibition athletes ranked in the top six, duplicate awards will be given.

10U, 11-12, YOUTH & ADAPTED ROUTINE EVENTS

OAS ribbons will be awarded to the top six routine scores in all 10U, 11-12, Youth and Adapted Routine events.

OAS Medals (rank 1-3) and OAS Ribbons (rank 4-6) will be awarded to the top six championship scores in all 10U, 11-12, Youth and Adapted Routine events.

JUNIOR/SENIOR TECHNICAL & FREE ROUTINE EVENTS

OAS Medals (rank 1-3) and OAS Ribbons (rank 4-6) will be awarded to the top six scores in all Junior and Senior Technical and Free events.

COMBO & ACROBATIC ROUTINE EVENTS

OAS Medals (rank 1-3) and OAS Ribbons (rank 4-6) will be awarded to the top six scores in Combo and Acrobatic Routine events.

MIXED ABILITY ROUTINE EVENTS

OAS Medals (rank 1-3) and OAS Ribbons (rank 4-6) will be awarded to the top six scores in Mixed Ability Team and Duet events
